

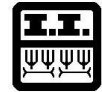

Cascading Moribana

Instructor: Lauren Paul



This arrangement will be a cascading moribana. You will need your choice of **3 large flowers** (lily, tulip, mum, etc.) and a few **small flowers** (mini carnation, button mum, etc.) **or 5 medium sized flowers** (iris, tulips, etc.) and a bit of filler material (limonium, wax flower, etc.), but this is optional.

Line material and additional greens will be provided for \$5. If you wish to bring your own, you will need 2 or 3 gently arching materials (asparagus fern, Italian ruscus, willow, etc.), and a couple of additional greens such as salal or leatherleaf, etc.

Please bring:

- ◆ Shoka container or raised bowl (compote) where the kenzan base sits no more than 3 inches below the rim.
- ◆ Large Kenzan
- ◆ Floral materials as described above.
- ◆ Hasami (floral shears)
- ◆ Plastic or newspaper to cover work area
- ◆ Towel for clean-up
- ◆ Camera to record your finished arrangement

Spring Moon Basket Workshop

This will be a modern (free style) interpretation of a traditional design. You will need **3 large spring flowers** (lily, Gerbera daisy, hyacinth, peony, rose, etc.) and some **filler material** (limonium, solidago, wax flower, etc.) **Foliage will be provided for \$5.** If you wish to bring your own, you will need two large leaves such as aralia and a few lily grass or similar long leaves.



If you have a full moon basket similar to those shown below, you may use it. Make sure it has a water holder and kenzan.

A limited number of moon baskets are available for \$25 each. You must reserve. Priority is given to chapter members, first come, first served. Reserved baskets that are not claimed at the workshop may be sold to another.

We will be using Oasis® Floral Foam in the new baskets. It will be provided with the basket at no additional charge, along with a water tray.

We will be using the basket again in a fall workshop.
